<u>The Sunday Akinsola Foundation for Widows & Orphans in Nigeria</u> – both locations had prayer, praise/worship, & teaching at their July monthly meetings. In Ogbomoso the ladies were given rice, potatoes, laundry detergent, & sodas. Four widows who really needed financial help were given \$30 each. They receive their income from selling fresh vegetables & cookies, candy, sodas to local school children.

The widows in **Kajola** had a snack at the meeting & were given (homemade) laundry detergent. The ministry has 30 widows in Ogbomoso & 80 in Kajola each with a waiting list. The goal is to be able to effectively disciple & minister within the finances & leadership available. The monthly meetings are a highlight in these women's lives to be able to dress up & fellowship with others in similar circumstances along with the joy of praying & worshiping.

<u>Prayer points from Abiodun:</u> * A bus needed that would hold about 20 people.

- * Two canopies each \$400 (in U.S. called tents) to have a crusade at each location (60 people).
- * Start construction in Kajola for a 2-story structure...have received City approval for plans. Building committee to make decisions on when to start construction. Estimated cost \$9,000 for that including bricks & labor to construct first floor. Also considering making their own concrete blocks for the first floor which would be stronger than the ones purchased.
