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The Sunday Akinsola Foundation for Widows & Orphans ministry in Nigeria –

For the August meetings in both location the Bible reference was from Psalm chapter 100

"Shout joyfully to the Lord, all the earth. Serve the Lord with gladness; Come before Him with joyful singing. Know that the Lord Himself is God; It is He who has made us, and not we ourselves; We are His people and the sheep of His pasture. Enter His gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise. Give thanks to Him, bless His name. For the Lord is good; His lovingkindness is everlasting and His faithfulness to all generations." (Psalm 100:1-5)

Ogbomoso widows' ministry celebrated the birthday of a friend of the ministry from the U.S. in honor of her birthday (although she wasn't there.) She wanted to bless the widows at both locations with a cash gift of \$2. They also had cookies & soda to take home.

They had prayer giving glory to God for the harvest of cassava (a healthy, energy-rich root vegetable) from the Akinsola Foundation's Garden. After the meeting, they went out & gathered the cassava by hand so it could be taken to a place that grinds it up in bulk to be processed & used in their homes for cooking.

The Kajola group celebrated one of their leaders' 50th birthday who has been faithful in leadership for fifteen years who continues to be a beacon of inspiration & guidance. They had a beautifully decorated cake that had been donated. The ladies were given \$2 each & the leaders \$7. The next phase of construction when funds are available is to install decorative lights in the large hall (sanctuary).
