

The Sunday Akinsola Foundation for Widows & Orphans in Nigeria – both locations had prayer, praise/worship, & teaching at their September monthly meetings. For a few months they both will continue the same theme but with different scriptural references to build their faith & believe God for good health & to rely on the Bible's promises rather than focusing on the former seasonal increase in sickness & death. Included in the teachings were Isaiah 54:17, "No weapon that is formed against you will prosper..." & other references.

In Ogbomoso two widows were given \$25 each to start a trade selling small things. That is enough to make a start for having a means for steady revenue. The ladies cooked a meal with chicken in a sauce for about forty-five people. They took home ready-to-eat pre-packaged meals & also yams & rice to cook.

In Kajola they received "Jiffy" cake mix to add water, spices, sodas, and cookies to take home. Construction has started with the concrete blocks made by the men hired to do the new building, which is next to the current one. Some widows were there praying and singing for a couple of hours outside where the men were beginning the project. They were asking God's blessing for the building & the ministry. The plan is to build the first floor & when finances are available to add the second floor.

Prayer points from Abiodun: * *A bus needed that would hold about 20 people.*

* *Two canopies each \$400 (in U.S. called tents) to have a crusade at each location (60 people).*

* *Prayer for finances to construct a 2-floor building.*
