**The Sunday Akinsola Foundation for Widows & Orphans ministry in Nigeria –**

Ogbomosho widows had a meeting in July with food cooked in big pots outside a day ahead of time that included Spanish rice topped with small fried fish which were packed in take-out containers & bottled water (to share with their children). The teaching was on emphasis of prayer & how it changes things. The reference was the story of Hannah from I Samuel, chapter one & how she prayed many years for a child & that God listened. The double "Ps" of prayer & patience were necessary. Hannah had many more children after Samuel. It was emphasized that if God asks you to wait, He knows how to solve a problem, so don't help Him by trying to make something happen.

The widows didn't meet in Kajola in the month of July because heavy rains had damaged the road at the chapel but do plan to meet in August.

Construction for the second floor to continue when more funds are received. The estimated amount needed is approximately \$8,000 for the roofing - then next plastering, windows, & finishing both floors inside.
