The Sunday Akinsola Foundation for Widows & Orphans ministry in Nigeria –

Both locations of Kajola & Ogbomosho had Thanksgiving meetings in November with the teaching emphasis on Psalm 113 to give thanks to God. There was a time for praise, prayer, and teaching.

A “friend” of the ministry from the US decided rather than have a big birthday party, instead donated funds for both locations to have special Thanksgiving services. Also, she gave about \$70 each to six widows to start a small trade. Both locations had a time of celebration with cake & various fruits such as oranges, bananas, pineapple, & pawpaws.

Kajola - cookies, sodas, bottled water, with rice & oats in take home bags.

Ogbomosho – food was cooked in advance of the meeting & put in take-home containers.

There are 30 widows & 6 leaders in Ogbomosho & 50 widows with 11 leaders in Kajola. The widows in Kajola have been fasting & praying for the partially completed building to be finished.

**A bus needed that would hold about 20 people.*

**Two canopies each \$550 (in U.S. called tents) to have a crusade at each location (60 people).*
