The Sunday Akinsola Foundation for Widows & Orphans ministry in Nigeria –

Both locations continued the teaching emphasis from Psalm 23 that God is the Shepherd & protector. Since September through December have seemingly been a season of more accidents & sicknesses, they were encouraged to focus on the Scriptures, prayer, & trusting God. To mark a milestone on her birthday, a woman in the U.S. donated enough fabric for each lady in both locations to have a new dress.

A special “In Remembrance” program at Kajola included four widows who shared their testimonies & experiences of how they had persevered through difficult circumstances. The ministry gave them each an honorarium of \$12. They were a real encouragement for the others. The widows have grown spiritually. The widows in both locations were given sodas, bottled water, & cookies which they took home. In Kajola a gift of a couple dollars & in Ogbomosho one dollar since bus fare is less in smaller town.

With limitations of space & finances, the leadership requested that the older ladies who had been attending for years just attend for special holidays that Christmas & Easter to make room for young widows who needed discipleship.

Construction for the second floor to continue when more funds are received. The estimated amount needed is approximately \$8,000 for the roofing - then next plastering, windows, & finishing both floors inside.

**A bus needed that would hold about 20 people.*

**Two canopies each \$550 (in U.S. called tents) to have a crusade at each location (60 people).*
