The Sunday Akinsola Foundation for Widows & Orphans ministry

Kajola & Ogbomosho, Nigeria –

The teaching emphasis for both locations in August was from Psalm 23 that God is our Shepherd & protector. From past experiences, September through December appears the most challenging time of the year when people seem more prone to have accidents & sicknesses. The widows were encouraged to hold fast & follow the Lord to overcome fear of what could happen to them or their loved ones. In addition to teaching from the Scriptures, the meetings have a time of praise & worship & intense prayer. The meetings in Kajola last about 3 hours & in Ogbomosho four to five hours.

The Kajola widows had cookies & bottled water at their meeting & attendees were given \$2, (leaders \$4) & raw chicken thighs cut up & divided to take home.

At the Ogbomosho monthly meeting, the widows had a snack & were given spaghetti pasta, grounded corn, & toothpaste to take home. The Akinsolas Foundation has about an acre of land used for crops to help feed the widows & children. The recently harvested corn was grounded up so could be cooked in various ways.

Construction for the women's chapel in Kajola for the second floor to continue when more funds are received. Please pray for the widows & orphans ministry including the leadership, that God's perfect will be accomplished in His timing.
