The Sunday Akinsola Foundation for Widows & Orphans ministry in Nigeria –

The February widows meeting in Ogbomosho focused on John 3:16 and the love of God. They received a bag to take home of cassava (when ground up like oatmeal). They were given \$1.50 each (\$5 for leaders) to help with bus fare. There is a garden at this location where vegetables are grown for the ministry. A gardener was hired for a small fee to grow vegetables & spray weeds. Currently he's planted 300 cassava plants & 300 sweet potato plants.

The Kajola widows did not have a regular meeting but instead took a road trip with a group of 40 ladies & attended the funeral for one of the pastor's mother. They rented a bus & traveled to another state. The transportation cost was \$7 each, which some were sponsored by people in the U.S. Arrangements were made for them to stay in a dormitory. The group of widows wanted to show their support for the pastor that had been with the ministry since its inception.

A priority for the ministry is to get the roof on the new building before the rainy season begins. When the building is completed, it will give the ministry a source of revenue since there is a need in the area for a rental location large enough for events such as weddings & conferences. The Akinsola Foundation hopes that after the building is finished to have a special program & invite widows to the entire county to be part of an outreach.
